



Turkey Hunting Safety Tips

Even with turkey season in full swing, hunters still need to be reminded of safety on each trip to the woods. Here are a few tips to help keep your hunting experience safe:

- Turkey hunters should wear camouflage. Don't have any red, white or blue colors showing. Remember, other hunters are looking for a spring gobbler displaying these colors.
- When determining a set-up position for a turkey, pick a location with a good back rest. A large tree, rock or dirt mound can protect you from the rear.
- Shout or whistle if another hunter comes near. Don't stand or wave your arms as the hunter could mistake your movement for a turkey.
